Section Two - Accomplishments within the Past Quarter:

Following is an overview of significant accomplishments within the past quarter:

<u>July 2023</u> – On July 17, 2023, the Lakeland City Commission approved the City's Request to Negotiate Agreement for Professional Engineering and Environmental Consulting Services with the top-ranked shortlisted firm.

<u>August 2023</u> – The City began contract negotiations with the top-ranked shortlisted firm, which included sending the proposed Agreement for Professional Engineering and Environmental Consulting Services for their review and approval and requesting the firm's submittal of a Bid Cost Proposal. The top-ranked firm submitted its Bid Cost Proposal, Detailed Estimate, and List of Assumptions to the City. Those documents were subsequently forwarded to DOC for final review and approval.

<u>September 2023</u> – The DOC responded to the City's submittal of the top-ranked firm's Bid Cost Proposal requesting a response to two questions, and the City immediately provided that response, anticipating final approval and authorization to move forward with the Professional Engineering & Environmental Consulting Services Agreement to begin the Environmental/Feasibility Phase of the Lake Bonnet Drainage Basin Flood Hazard and Debris Mitigation project.

Section Three – Issues or risks that have been faced with resolutions:

The City experienced a significant delay awaiting DOC's review of the City's top-ranked bidder's Bid Cost Proposal and Detailed Estimate to gain final approval to move forward with executing the Professional Engineering & Environmental Consulting Services for the Lake Bonnet Drainage Basin Flood Hazard and Debris Mitigation. **Prior to submitting this QPR (October 2023), the City received DOC's approval of the referenced documents.

The City will move forward with the execution of the Professional Engineering & Environmental Consulting Services for the Lake Bonnet Drainage Basin Flood Hazard and Debris Mitigation, schedule and hold a Project Kick-Off Meeting/Public Meeting to begin the Feasibility/Environmental Phase of the Project.
