<u>January 2024</u> - Initial Project Information Public Kick-Off Meeting collaterals were reviewed, approved, and executed.

<u>February 2024</u> – The City received from DOC Amendment One to the Federally Funded CDBG-MIT Subrecipient Agreement on Feb. 5, 2024, for City approval and signature. A rehearsal meeting was held on Feb. 12, 2024, with internal stakeholders and the City's Consultant for the Public Kick-Off Meeting. The Initial Project Information Public Kick-Off Meeting was held on Thursday, Feb. 15, 2024, at The Well. 37 residents attended in person, and 24 attended online via GoToWebinar. The City's Consultant Drone Survey Team completed a Drone Survey (LIDAR) of the project area.

<u>March 2024</u>—The City's Consultant is currently performing a Wetlands Survey and has accomplished the following activities: Wildlife Survey, Geotechnical work for the project area, acquisition of Water depths utilizing a dual-frequency sonar depth sounder, and completion of Survey work for the floodplain mitigation studies.
