


ABOUT LFD

Established in 1916, the Lakeland Fire Department has a rich service history serving approximately 120,000+ people in the City of Lakeland. The department responds to more than 30,000 service calls annually in its 84 square-mile response area. LFD is rated as an ISO 1 Department with more than 200 employees, 7 fire stations, an administration building, training center, and vehicle maintenance facility.

Lakeland Fire Department provides Advanced Life Support (ALS) services and is a non-transport career department. Offering a wide range of services, LFD firefighters are skilled and trained for technical rescue, fire prevention, fire code enforcement, fire investigation, aircraft rescue and firefighting, as well as the high-quality level of fire suppression and emergency medical response for which the department is known.
