

Recommendations


- · Index the growth portion of the portfolio.
- Utilize active management on the other parts of the portfolio where it has been successful.
- Change target allocations to managers so that tracking error is reduced and consistency of performance is improved.

Tyler recommended using CAPIS as our transition manager to move assets, if possible, or cash to new Index fund. Rick stated Polen has been a concern for some time, but why Vanguard Large Cap. Tyler stated they cannot out-perform market. Chris Holway wanted to know percentage of managers that beat index, Tyler stated 7%.

Large Cap Growth Is it just us?



Ruffin Gray made motion accepting recommendation to replace Polen and Vanguard Large Cap Index Admiral into Vanguard Russell 1000 Growth Index I. All in favor.

Tyler and Paul reviewed DC Plans. Current value at \$155M. One investment – Invesco – is underperforming, and even if decide to keep in place, need to evaluate options.
