Please note that to move forward to a traffic calming student, the petition must contain signatures of a minimum of 25 persons or at least 50% of the property owners in the Neighborhood (one per street address), whichever is smaller.

For the purposes of this petition, Neighborhood is defined as any contiguous area within the city that generally has as its boundaries:

- 1. The interior right-of-way line of any arterial or collector street;
- 2. The interior boundary or right-of-way line of any railroad, utility, or pipeline corridor, river or waterway (not including drainage or flood control ditches) not being transversed by roadways in the general locale;
- 3. The City limits;
- 4. Any combination of one or more of the foregoing boundaries.

A Neighborhood in this meaning may consist of one or more subdivisions and/or homeowners associations. The Manager of Traffic Operations may adjust the boundary of a neighborhood based on judgment or special conditions.

Arterial street shall mean a high-capacity roadway whose primary function is to move traffic from one location to another.

Collector Street shall mean a public roadway that collects traffic from local roadways and delivers them to arterial streets.
